It has been a quick week for us, and time has gotten away. Much is taking place all over the world, but one big focus is on the North Korea 'missile crisis' which seems to get worse by the week, and another on Turkey and the Netherlands.

The United States has placed more presence than ever for its allies in the region as North Korea's Supreme Leader, Kim Jong-Un, continues to build on his nuclear capable missile arsenal. This past week the Aircraft Carrier, the USS Carl Vinson, berthed in a South Korean port as a show of force, and as a participant in the annual naval exercises with South Korea.

It remains to be seen what North Korea's reaction will be, but anything is possible with such an easily agitated rogue leader.

Meanwhile another unpredictable leader, Turkish President Erdogan, in a bid to gain more power at home in Turkey, is pushing at the Netherlands Turkish ministers were prevented from addressing election rallies, and Mr. Erdogan called the Dutch "Nazi fascists."


It remains to be seen how far the Turkish leader will continue to push this rhetoric since the Netherlands has been a major economic partner for Turkey. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has accused Erdogan of pursuing the goal of establishing a neo-Ottoman empire using the Muslim Brotherhood ideology, not just within Turkey. It is amazing the Erdogan has lasted as long as he has, but perhaps he will play into the end-time King of the North and King of the South scenario mentioned in the book of Daniel. (Dan 11:40-41)
