Greetings from Phoenix,

Here we are as we end the 2nd week of the new administration for the United States, and surprisingly much has happened around the world. President Trump faces in many cases a contemptuous response by European and other leaders. The president of the EU, Donald Tusk, has said that the three greatest threats facing Europe is Russia, China, and Trump.

Despite the threats and attacks by radical Muslims against the peoples of Europe the leaders including German Chancellor Angela Merkel have a business-as-usual approach towards the flood of migrants into the EU countries. It is likely that attacks from ISIS and other Muslim radicals will continue to occur in Europe in the coming year.

Dan 11: 35-40 and Revelation 13 give us a window into the mind of this man:

**Daniel 11:35-40 (NKJV)** <sup>35</sup> **And some of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify *them*, and make *them* white, until the time of the end; because *it is* still for the appointed time.<sup>36</sup> “Then the king shall do according to his own will: he shall exalt and magnify himself above every god, shall speak blasphemies against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the wrath has been accomplished; for what has been determined shall be done. <sup>37</sup> He shall regard neither the God<sup>[a]</sup> of his fathers nor the desire of women, nor regard any god; for he shall exalt himself above *them* all. <sup>38</sup> But in their place he shall honor a god of fortresses; and a god which his fathers did not know he shall honor with gold and silver, with precious stones and pleasant things. <sup>39</sup> Thus he shall act against the strongest fortresses with a foreign god, which he shall acknowledge, *and* advance *its* glory;**

and he shall cause them to rule over many, and divide the land for gain. <sup>40</sup> "At the time of the end the king of the South shall attack him; and the king of the North shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter the countries, overwhelm *them*, and pass through."

We live in rapidly changing times which are preparing a stage for this dark, foreboding leader to arise like Adolf Hitler did during WWII.

It behooves us in these critical time to watch and keep on our toes spiritually. The Word of God will be fulfilled!
